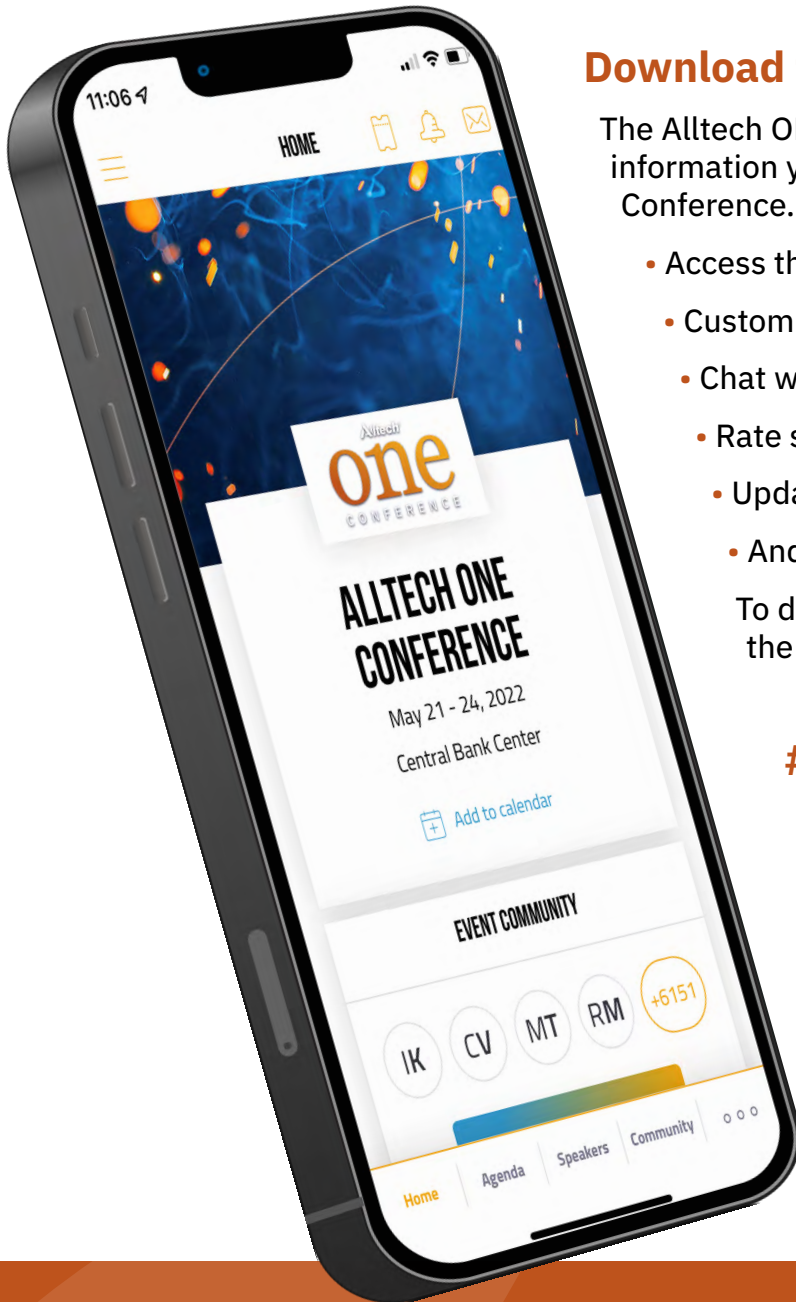

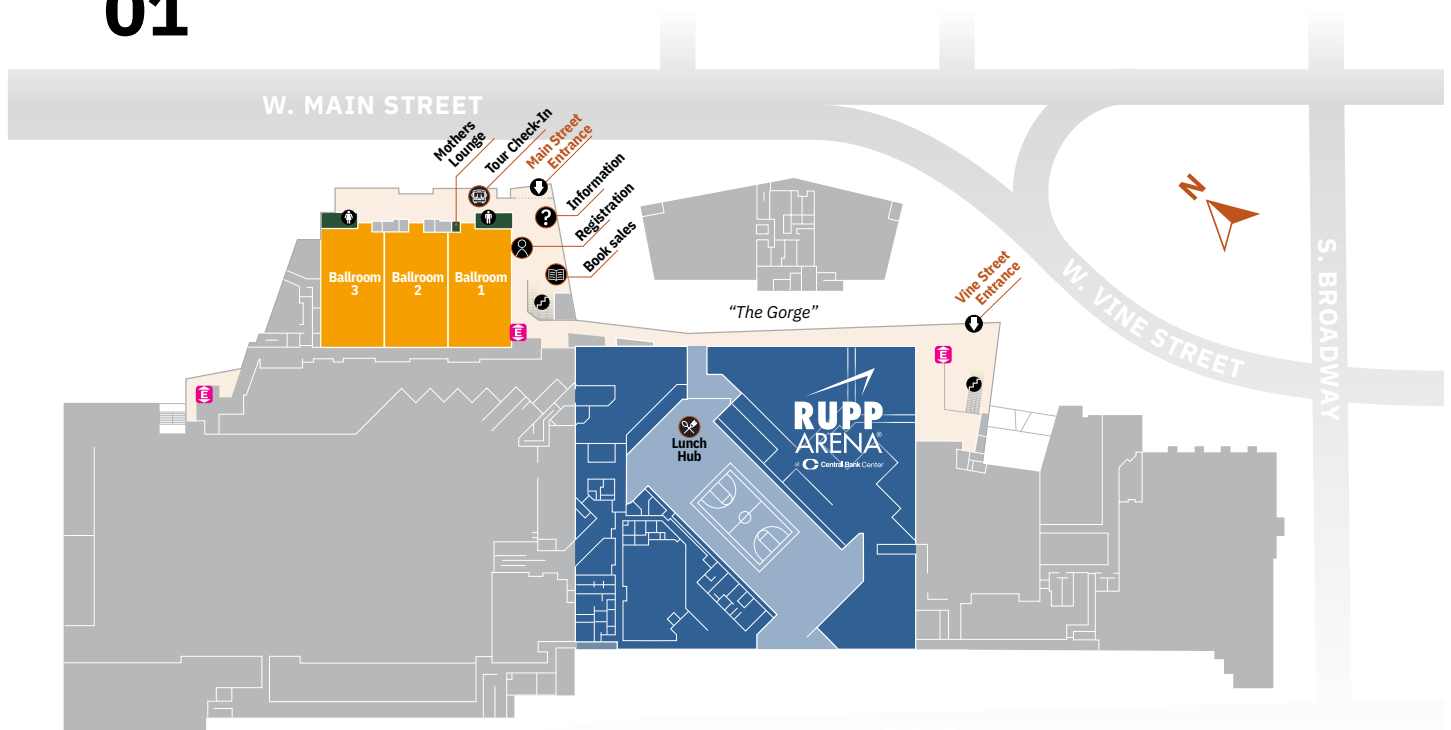

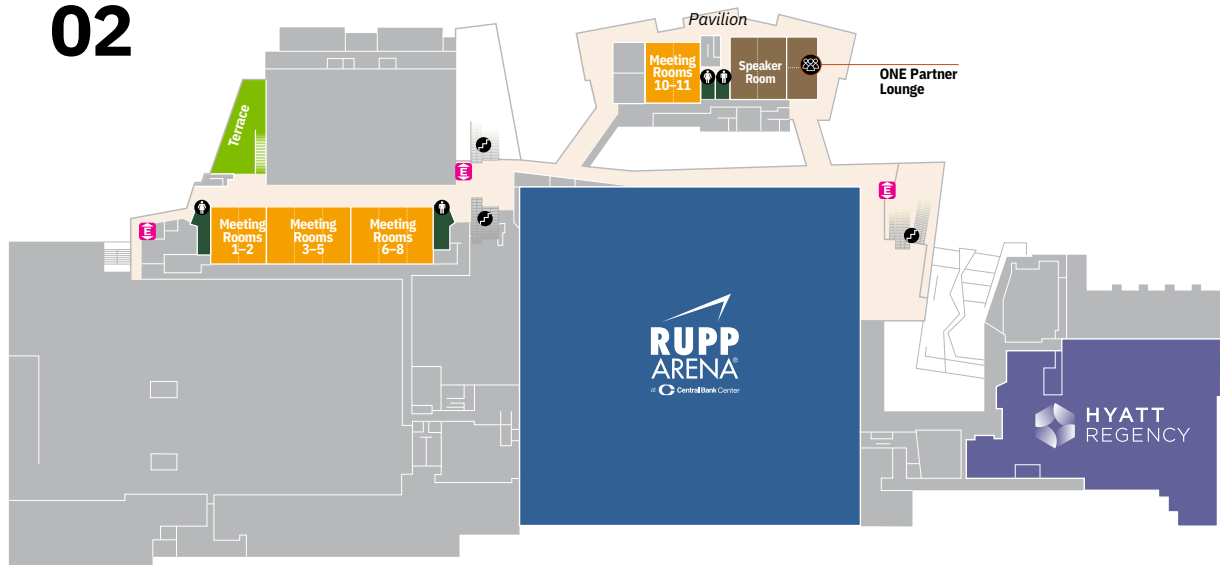
Central Bank Center Map

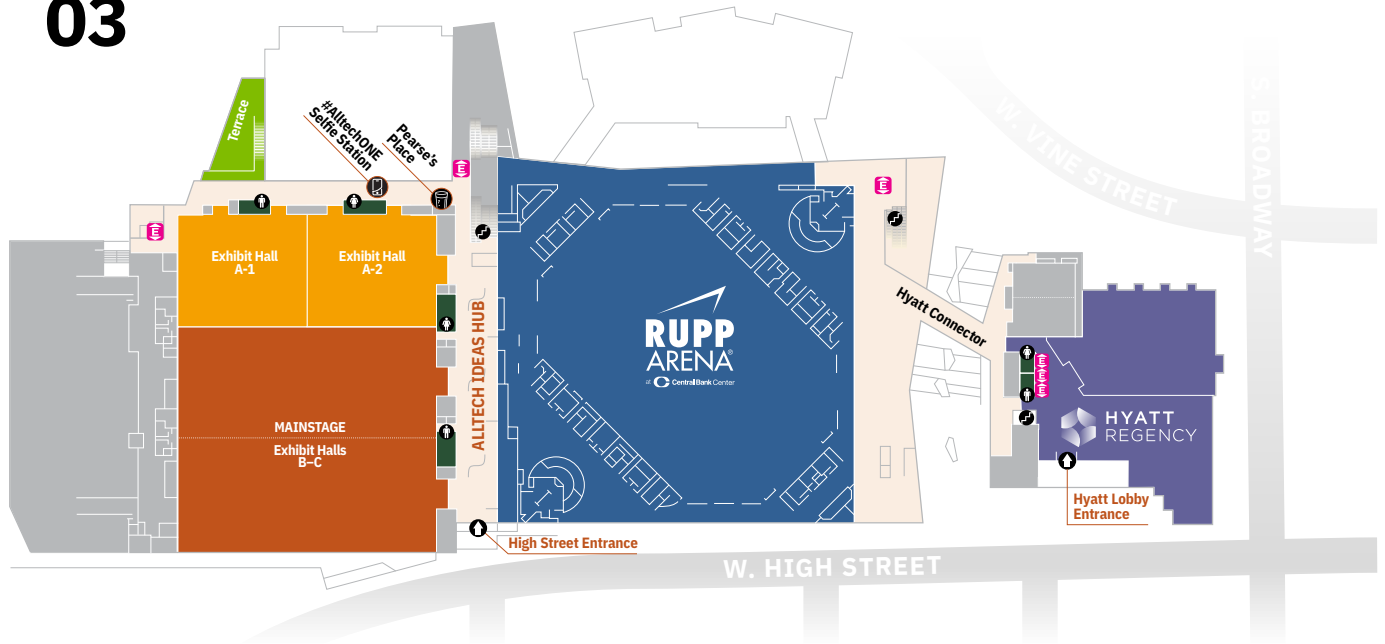

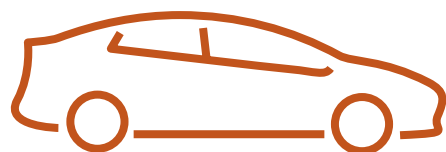
Event Transportation

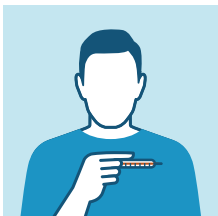
